- 1) Snowbird resort has a range of outdoor activities from self-guided hiking to slides and a ropes course. All activities at Snowbird are pay-as-you go on an individual basis. - 2) **SaltLakeCityTours will provide an option for a Salt Lake City tour.** Pickup will be at 12:30 pm in front of the Cliff Lodge. Cost is \$85 per person plus tax. Signup for the tour can be added to conference registration for new registrations.
